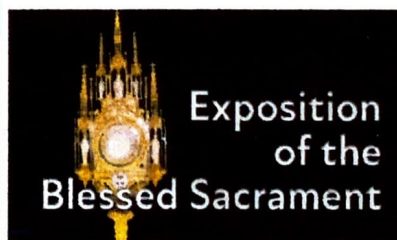

### CENTRE FOR FAITH ENRICHMENT

The following courses are being offered ONLINE by the Archdiocesan Centre for Faith Education:

#### CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING: AN INTRODUCTION

The course takes students through the social doctrines of the Church, which flows from understanding the human person as the image of God, infinitely loved and made for eternal life in Christ. Students will learn the main tenets and principles of the Church's social teaching, in particular, the Catholic understanding of justice, love, truth, freedom, respect for the dignity of human life, the common good, subsidiarity, solidarity and how this impacts understanding the human work, politics, economic life, culture, the environment and the achievement of peace in society.

#### HISTORY OF THE EARLY CHURCH: THE STORY BEGINS

The course explores the life of the early Church, from its origins and development in the Jewish, Greek and Roman environment, to the Apostolic Fathers and Apologists that first defined its identity. We will look at how the early Christians suffered under great persecutions until the rise of the Roman Emperor Constantine and the Christianisation of the Roman Empire. Other points of focus will be: the Christian understanding of the nature of God, the great councils, the Holy Trinity, the relations between divinity and humanity in Christ, and the importance of seeing God's purpose in the world.
