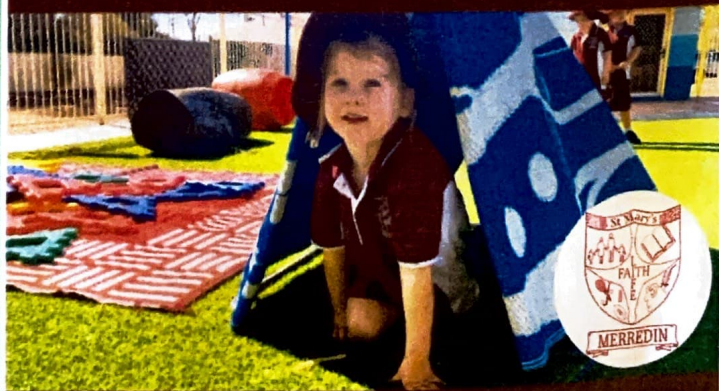

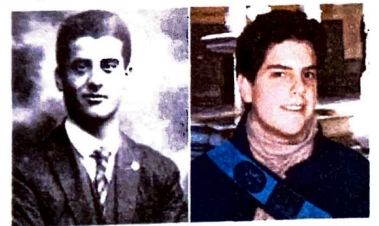


Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati were canonized on Sunday, 7 September

The canonizations of the two young saints, one from the twentieth century and one from the twenty-first century have been greatly anticipated due to the great devotion among the faithful.

The late Pope Francis had announced the canonizations of Blessed Pier Giorgio and Carlo at the General Audience of 20 November 2024, prompting thunderous applause from the crowds gathered in St. Peter's Square.

The canonization of Acutis, who was beatified in Assisi on 10 October 2020, had originally been scheduled for 27 April, the Second Sunday of Easter, to coincide with the Jubilee of Teenagers, while Frassati's canonization had been set for 3 August, the culmination of the Jubilee for Youth. Pope Leo made the choice to enroll among the number of the saints two young men from different eras who led completely different lives, but who are nonetheless united in their love for Christ and their ability to impart that love to those whose lives they touched.
