

CATHOLIC MISSION SUNDAY



The Rosary is a form of vocal and mental prayer on the mysteries of our Redemption, divided into 20 decades. The recitation of each decade is accompanied by meditation on one of the 20 events or "mysteries." The mysteries consist of 4 groups. JOYFUL, LIGHT, SORROWFUL and GLORIOUS.

When we pray the Rosary, we meditate on the life of Jesus Christ and on the glory of heaven. Each part of the Rosary is devoted to a particular incident in the life of Jesus Christ. His life and ministry is very much connected to ours. When we meditate on the mysteries of the Rosary, we are doing what the early Church did, "devoting our prayer with Mary, the mother of Jesus" (Acts 1:14). She will help us understand Jesus as only a mother can.

The "Hail Mary", one of the popular Catholic prayers,

based on the Gospel of St Luke, chapter one.




