Saint Mary of the Cross MacKillop

Mary MacKillop was born in Melbourne and worked as a governess and a teacher to support her family, In 1866 she founded St Joseph's School, the first free Catholic School in Australia. With Fr Julian Tenison Woods she founded an order of nuns, the Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart. They opened many schools and other

charitable institutions, and continue to this day. She was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on 17 October 2010: the first Australian saint.

There are around 900 members of the Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart (the Josephites) living and working globally, with the vast majority based across Australia and New Zealand
